	Locations	Volunteer Opportunities
Cat Dog	In your home	<b>Fostering:</b> Caring for pets in your home and facilitating adoptions. May include transporting to and from adoption events. Training provided.
Cat Dog	Various Locations	<b>Adoption Events:</b> Introduce adoptable pets to the public. May include transporting pets to and from events. Training provided.
	UAF Rescue Ranch	<b>Dog Walking:</b> Walk dogs on the Peavine trail near the UAF Rescue Ranch. Dog handling training provided and required by UAF.
	Kitty City (inside Petco) UAF Rescue Ranch	<b>Cat Care:</b> Clean kitty condos and litter boxes; feed cats and socialize with them. Must be able to bend, reach, and lift. Kitty City shifts are in the morning and afternoon only. Requires talking to the public. Training required and provided by UAF.
	Furr-tastic Finds Thrift Store	<b>Thrift Store:</b> Accept, clean, sort, and price donations from the public. Assist in keeping store stocked. Must be able to bend, lift, and climb stairs.
	UAF Rescue Ranch	<b>Pet Food Bank:</b> Help load and distribute cat and dog food once a month or help unload truckload donations. Must be able to lift heavy bags.
	In your home	<b>Phone Lines:</b> Retrieve emails that are voice transcribed calls. Work one or two days a week from home, forwarding emails to the appropriate UAF party or providing information to callers.
	In your home	<b>Grant Writing:</b> Experience with grant applications is preferred.
	Various Locations	<b>Fundraising:</b> Participate in events such as Hike for Hounds, dinners, auctions, etc. Includes setup, teardown, and talking to the public.
	UAF Rescue Ranch	<b>Building Maintenance:</b> Repairs and upkeep at the UAF Rescue Ranch.
	Snip n' Go Clinic	In person. Morning check-in, afternoon check-out, or instrument packing. Vet tech skills needed (if experienced)

- Will indemnify, defend, and hold harmless UAF and its officers, directors, agents, and volunteers from and against any and all liability, claims, demands, damages, lawsuits, injuries, losses, judgments, costs or other expenses whatsoever, sustained by any companion animal or any person as a direct or an indirect result of or in connection with my performance of volunteer activities for UAF or my breach of UAF's rules, policies, guidelines or programs or as a result of the failure to perform the volunteer services.
- Will promptly return any UAF property, records, and funds to the organization if I stop being a volunteer for UAF for any reason or upon UAF's request.
- Understand and agree that UAF may refuse volunteer applications for any reason.
- Understand that the UAF Board reserves the right to dismiss any volunteer who does not abide by the terms of this agreement or who in any way degrades the image of United Animal Friends.
